


HOW TO SET UP THE ADWAYS VAST LOADER BRIGHTCOVE PLUGIN

# 1. SETUP THE CUSTOM FIELD

How to add the custom field « Adways Publication ID »?

1. Log in <https://studio.brightcove.com>
2. Click the **ADMIN** link in the Studio header.
3. Click th **VIDEO FIELDS** link.
4. Click the link **Click here to configure your fields.**
5. Click the **Add custom fields** button.
6. Fill in the table with the following datas:
  1. Required: **no**
  2. Display Name: **Adways VAST URL**
  3. Internal Name: **adways\_vast\_url**
  4. Description: **VAST URL VPAID2 VAST3, type/application: javascript if your player has the Adways Vast Loader plugin.**
7. Click on **Save.**

## 2. SETUP THE VAST LOADER PLUGIN

How to set up a player that will be able to get and read the custom field 'Adways Vast URL'?

1. Log in <https://studio.brightcove.com>
2. Click the **PLAYERS** link in the Studio header.
3. Select the player that you want to use.
4. In the **PLUGINS** field, click on **Edit**.
5. In the **JAVASCRIPT** field, enter this Javascript URL [//play.adpaths.com/libs/plugins/brightcovevastloader.js](https://play.adpaths.com/libs/plugins/brightcovevastloader.js) and press +.
6. In the **Name, Options (JSON)** field, enter this Plugin name [AdwaysBrightcoveVastLoaderPlugin](#) and press +.
7. In the **Plugin options (formatted as JSON)** field, you can force a VAST URL, enter: `{"adwaysVastUrl": "https://example.com/my-vast.xml"}`
8. Click on **Save**.



2. Click the **MEDIA** link in the Studio header.
3. Select the media for which you want to add the interactive layer.
4. In the **CUSTOM FIELDS** field, click on **Edit**.
5. Add the **Adways Vast URL**, click on **Save**.
6. Click the **PUBLISH** link under the Studio header.
7. Select the player where the plugin Adways has been added.
8. Get the code! This code includes the interactive layer.
